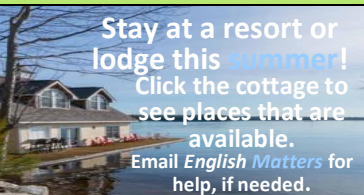

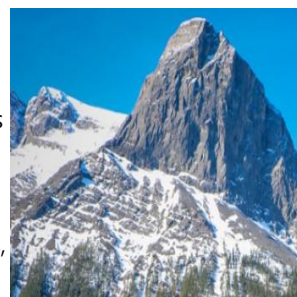

The 2 biggest cities in Alberta are Edmonton, the capital, and  
Calgary, home of the **Calgary Stampede**, a summer rodeo.

You can explore the majestic beauty of the Canadian Rockies here,

is protected in the parks. There are even overpasses and underpasses

here are grizzly bears, black bears, sheep, deer, elk, wolverine, wolves,  
coyotes, cougars, moose, and lynx.



**Dinosaur Provincial Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site**, is one of the
